

Participation terms for the Treetop Adventure

1. Every participant must read the terms of use before setting out on the Treetop Adventure. The parents or guardians of a participant under 18 years of age must read the participation terms and discuss these with the minor before he/she is allowed to start the Treetop Adventure.
2. The park is open to all visitors from 6 years of age (the Treetop Adventure parks Sayn and Vulkanpark offer courses for younger participants who can either reach a height of 1.20 m or are accompanied by their parents) weighing up to 120 kg who do not suffer from an illness or psychological impairment that could pose a risk to their own health or that of others when using the equipment in the park. The participant is required to be sufficiently physically fit to manoeuvre the course. Health impairments, which may be a reason for exclusion are e.g.: psychological impairments, recent operations, epilepsy, heart disease, joint injuries or pregnancy. Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult (the exception being supervised group programmes), the admission restrictions indicated must be observed. In the case of minors, the parent/guardian must give his/her consent in writing (below). Persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs are not allowed to enter the climbing park.
3. No objects that pose a threat to the participant or others (jewellery, mobile phones, cameras, etc.) may be worn/carried when using the climbing park. Long hair must be tied back with a hair tie. It is imperative that sturdy, closed shoes be worn.
4. Each and every participant must pay attention to the safety demonstration before beginning the Treetop Adventure. All instructions given and decisions made by the operators/trainers are binding. Should instructions or safety requirements be ignored or violated, operators/trainers reserve the right to remove the participant from the Treetop Adventure. Should instructions or safety requirements be ignored or violated, the operators/trainers of Freiraum Erlebnis GmbH assume no liability for any resulting damage.
5. The rented equipment (helmet, harness, safety line) must be used as instructed by the operator/trainer. It may not be transferred to others, may not be removed during the use of the climbing park, and must be returned 3 or 5 hours after handover, depending on the tariff booked. Each additional half hour or part thereof will be charged at 3 euros per person. The belt should only be removed before using the toilet. After putting it on again, it must be inspected by a trainer to ensure the correct fit, only thereafter is a continuation of the course permitted. Smoking is not permitted whilst wearing the harness. The safety carabiners must be attached to the safety rope when climbing. Be sure to also attach the Smart Belays. Ensure that a safety carabiner is always attached while moving on to the next step. Never unhook both safety carabiners from the safety rope at the same time. If in doubt, please call a trainer.
6. No more than one person at a time may climb a single section. There may be no more than max 3 people on a platform at the same time. Participants must be secured according to the trainers' instructions.
7. The management reserves the right to exclude any person from the park who does not comply with these terms of use. The organiser reserves the right to cancel, restrict or interrupt activities at the park for the participants' safety and due to adverse weather conditions. The rights of the participant, in particular according to section 314 of the German civil code (BGB) and sections 323, 346 et seq. BGB, remain unaffected in this case.
8. The firm Freiraum Erlebnis GmbH, its legal representatives or agents are only liable in cases of intent or gross negligence. In the event of a breach of essential obligations, the organiser may be held liable in cases of simple negligence. This liability is, however, limited to contractual damage. This shall not affect damages resulting from injury to life, limb or health as well as mandatory legal liability regulations.
